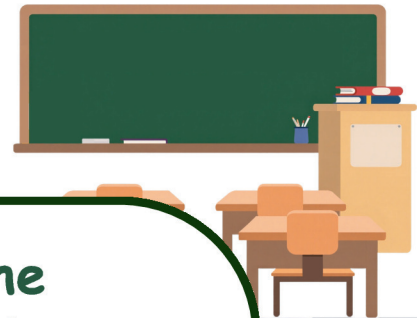

## AIM for Seva - A Journey of Care & Commitment

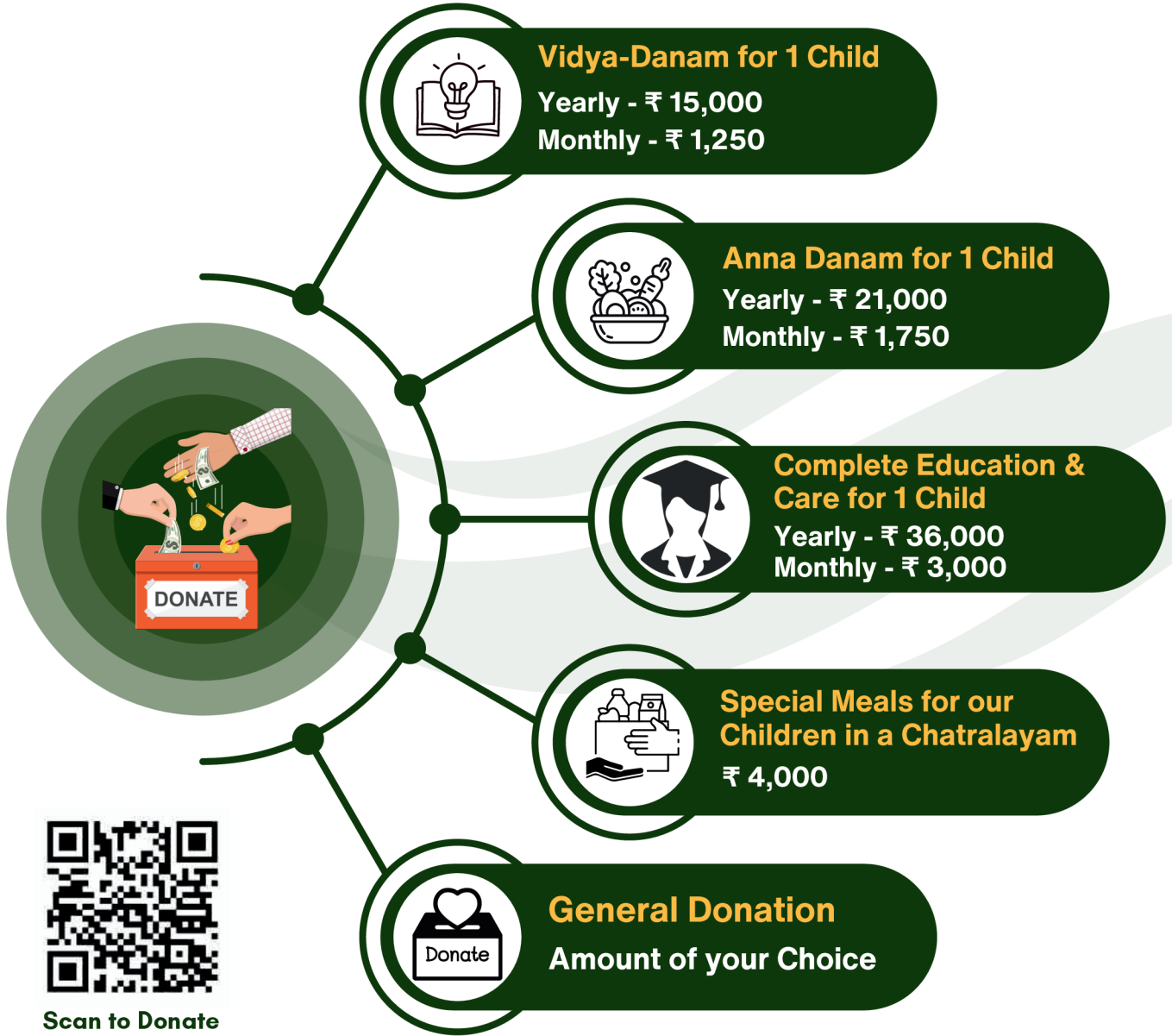
